## GOVERNOR VISIT PROTOCOL – 1 Page Summary

## Meeting with the Board of Directors

- Hold the meeting in a location separate from that of the club meeting, if possible.
- This is not an ordinary BOD meeting. No ordinary business items.
- The Governor will orchestrate the meeting after you kick it off.
- Briefly summarize your vision for the club during your year.
- Chairs Report on their areas. Concentrate on Membership, Foundation and Public Image, but cover everything that is important to your club. Plan on using about half the available time.
- Expect the Governor to make comments and ask questions.
- Anticipate that the Governor's spouse, if with the Governor, may have a word or two to share sometime during the BOD meeting.

## Meeting with the Full Club

- Ensure that there is no other program scheduled for the day of the Governor's visit. (The Governor's Presentation will be the Program.)
- Significant awards, presentations, & inductions by the Governor are OK and even encouraged; however, coordinate this in advance. No Surprises.
- The Assistant Governor will introduce the Governor to the club, after you first introduce the Assistant Governor. (A simple one- sentence introduction of the Assistant Governor by you will suffice.) All club members should stand in honor of **the office** of the District Governor. The District Governor is an officer of Rotary International the only one in the district.)

## **Advance Preparation**

(The AG, with input from the Club President, should send the following Information to the District Governor 14 days before the official visit.)

- Location(s) and times of meetings with club Board and the whole club, with directions.
- Signature club project(s) with a brief description.
- Fund raising project(s) identified for the year. List with date(s).
- Names of club members who have held district positions with position(s) and date(s).
- Will the Governor be inducting a new member(s) or presenting Rotary Foundation recognition(s) at the official visit? Identify and specify RF Recognition level.
- Other individuals or Information that Governor should be aware of for the visit.
- Key suggestions that should be made to this club by the District Governor.
