



Through the generosity of Georgia Rotarians we are able to offer our friendship to young men and women from other countries in the interest of understanding, not merely being understood. While these young people consider themselves "ambassadors" of their countries, we Rotarians of Georgia are the examples by which they judge the United States. Being conscious of our responsibilities, we ourselves become better



citizens of our own country. As is always the case, in the application of "Service Above Self", the giver benefits as does the receiver.

There is not another program like it in Rotary today. Since 1946, Georgia Rotarians have funded these scholarships, and to date there have been approximately 3600 alumni of GRSP.

Our plan provides that the scholarship will cover the cost of tuition, books, room and meals. The scholarship does not provide any funds for travel within the country, transportation to and from the student's home country, or medical insurance. The scholarship is for one academic year. About 45 scholarships are awarded each year to students who are academically able to enter a college or university for undergraduate work. The program does not contemplate any "exchange" of these students and there is no obligation on the part of other countries to reciprocate and offer scholarships to students from Georgia.





To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, clubs need to begin the year as active clubs that are in good standing and remain so throughout the year. Achievements will be compared with membership figures from 1 July 2019 and will be recognized after the 1 July 2020 numbers are final, on 15 August 2020.

As a Rotarian engaged in business or profession, I am expected to:


- Consider my vocation to be another opportunity to serve;
