

# District Grand Frequently Asked Questions

## FAQs

1. Who can, or has to, attended the Annual Grant Qualification Seminar?

The President Elect or Club Foundation Chair

2. Can we get matching funds for third-party contributions to the District Grant?

No. The District only matches the Club's contribution.

3. Can District Grants be used for international projects?

Yes, but – because these are small grants – they are usually used to improve the local community

6. When will the club get the matching funds?

Checks are usually sent to the clubs in mid-August.

7. When can we start the project?

You can start the project and spend club funds after July 1. Matching grant funds can be spent as soon as received.

8. Can the club spend additional funds beyond the matching grant?

Yes. In fact, many clubs do spend additional funds.

9. Who can sign the final report?

Whoever your club designates as having primary responsibility for the project

10. What happens if the club doesn't meet the deadlines?

You club will not be eligible to receive matching funds for the next grant year. Note: Your club is still responsible for submitting a final report by July 1 even if you do not receive a grant for the following year.

11. What happens if we don't spend all the funds?

Unspent funds more than \$500 must be returned to the district office by May 15. (Return the funds earlier if possible.)

12. What happens if we don't complete the project?

If the project is not completed, all matching funds must be returned to the district office by May 15 or earlier.

13. When is a club notified of the acceptance and the amount of the matching District Grant funds awarded to their Club?

In June the club is notified of the acceptance and the amount of the matching funds.

14. Can Clubs go together in sponsoring a District Grant?

Yes, Clubs can join together to sponsor a District Grant.
