Rotary District 6910 is prepared to award needs-based District 6910 Education Scholarships to qualified graduating high school students with a one-time award of a \$2,000 to one student per Rotary Club for a total of five (5) scholarships awarded annually, not to exceed \$10,000.

- Peace & Conflict Prevention/Resolution
- Disease Prevention & Treatment
- Water & Sanitation
- Maternal & Child Health

- Basic Education & Literacy
- Economic & Community Development
- Environment
